BMS Gets New Student Lab

A new 32 seat student lab has been installed at BMS

New Student lab begins operation in October of 2011. This lab expands the ability of BMS teachers to utilize technology in many content areas. Reservations for the lab are constant and reflect the pent up demand for additional technology.



Funding for this lab was a cooperative effort between BMS and Technology. However, no unbudgeted funds were used to add this functionality to the District.

District to Deploy New Copiers— Savings to the District is Significant

The District has come to terms on a new copier lease. recently a request for bids took place and vendors submitted their proposals it was decided that Brush would use the services of Lewan Xerox for our copier services.



Not only does Brush receive all new copiers, both color and b&w, but the cost savings using this new service really add up. The District will **save over \$30K** each year. That savings alone is nearly the amount needed to hire or maintain one teaching FTE.

The deployment of these copiers will provide each teacher the opportunity to use both a primary and a backup copier as a printer. Lewan also ensures rapid 4 hour response to copier issues.

As we move forward in a digital age there is great hope that each of us will pay conscious attention our use of paper. We need to ask: Are there ways to use technology to deliver this content.
