

CARL & JESSIE HUTCHINSON VETERAN'S OF FOREIGN WARS SCHOLARSHIP

1. The scholarship is awarded annually to one or two seniors from BHS or Riverview Christian HS with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
2. The scholarship may be used at any accredited vocational/trade school, community college, college or university in the state of Colorado.
3. The student may major in any field of study.
4. The amount of the scholarship will always be the same each year, \$1,000. It will be mailed directly to the college financial aid office in care of the recipient.
5. The scholarship is awarded annually and is non-renewable. It is always awarded to a high school senior.
6. A committee will select the finalist. The committee will consist of a representative of each of the high schools that have applicants, and the Veteran's of Foreign Wars will make the final decision.
7. Although the scholarship will not be rescinded, the Veteran's of Foreign Wars Post #3551 expects an academic progress report on the recipient. The report can be made after the close of the first half of the academic year.
8. The recipient can receive other scholarships. The award is to be based on need and merit.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS AND SCHOOL OFFICIALS

1. Applicants should prepare a folder containing: completed application form, transcript which includes: class rank, a personal letter, and two letters of recommendation.
2. Use either a typewriter or print your application in ink.
3. Applicants must have participated in the Voices of Democracy program.
4. Your letter should include and explain any information you feel is important that was not covered in the application. Also, include the reasons you plan to continue your education beyond high school, your ambitions, goals, and reasons you feel you merit consideration.
5. The folder should be completed and given to your high school counselor by **April 15**.
